#### **July Artist of the Month**



Was born in southwestern Ontario and spent his formative years in the small town of Ridgetown, Ontario. Immediately after graduating high school, he joined the military and spent 25 years travelling the world as his primary employment that took him from Canada to the Middle East and on to Europe.

In 1985, he transferred to the part time military reserves and pursued various jobs in the civilian world. Those ambitions eventually saw him move to Leduc in the year 2000 where he, and his wife Yvonne, settled in and found employment in a number of professional positions. Wayne joined the energy sector in various senior management positions and Yvonne in the Alberta education system.

Wayne retired in 2016. He now spends most of his time planning vacations, watching his two grandsons play hockey in Leduc, and enjoying his retirement community.

Retirement led Wayne to explore a past time that had always interested him but other priorities seemed to push art to one side. Prior to the dark days of the

COVID pandemic, Wayne decided to enroll in a beginners' art class sponsored by the Leduc Art Club. It was only after a few short sessions in class he had found his inner passion. With the encouragement of his fellow students and his wife he began to apply his skills on a regular basis.

Suddenly the world became a much smaller place and health restrictions left only one place to paint. The basement studio was occupied on a daily basis primarily to think of ideas, to find quality reference images, and to experiment with brushes and paint. Two years later he emerged with dozens of canvases that progressed from beginner to what has been described as pleasing works of art.

"I'm hooked and, notwithstanding family priorities, I still head to the studio on a regular basis. The results have been favorable," admits Wayne, "Love it."
