Starting January 25, 2024 LAF is moving **Open Studio Thursdays**

to the Foundry Downtown location on Main Street. The address is 4815 50 Ave Leduc in the old Star Catholic Outreach location next to Nail World.

From Brittany Snellen - We will continue this free open studio day for the next 18 months. Originally, open studio was planned as a temporary day, as we changed our membership structure, however, now that we have a new space that we are excited to share, we are extending that opportunity until June

2025! Between now and then you can expect to see us starting up our pottery studio in the

space– that's right, we are getting a KILN downtown!– and **opening the new ArtWorks** store, which will offer goods from local artists and artisans! You can find an application on our website if you are interested in being a vendor!

We are moving Open Studio to the other location so that people can start to become acquainted with our Downtown space, which offers ample parking (both on Main Street, and even more behind in the ATB parking lot!), we also have TWO bathrooms in this facility, a wheelchair accessible ramp at the back door, and coffee shops and restaurants within walking distance!

Open Studio on Thursdays will ONLY be offered at the downtown location, as we have some plans in the making for Thursdays at the LRC location.


